IQAC makes it a tradition to mandatorily collect feedback from stakeholders- students, teachers, alumni and employers. This is done by a feedback committee. They collect and analyse the feedback and make suggestions to the appropriate bodies.

Objective:

The objective of the exercise is to correctly gauge the impact of all the efforts taken by the institution at all levels on the various stakeholders. The institution wants the benefits to reach all the stakeholders. This feedback is collected and trends generated through statistical analysis. Based on the opinion of the stakeholders, further action is taken by the feedback committee.

Methodology:

- Feedback on curriculum is collected from students by circulating the Feedback Forms. It is collected and brought to IQAC for further analysis. The Statistical data is handed over to the Feedback committee. Further suggestions are incorporated by departments, and head of the institution.
- Alumni Feedback is collected during alumni meetings or sent online. The filled forms are sent for further action
- Feedback is collected from teachers by circulating the feedback forms. Subsequent action is similar to the other forms.
- The teachers or peers also give feedback which is collected and forwarded to the authorities for further action.
- The feedback committee collects inputs and suggestions from the stakeholders and further action to be taken is discussed with departments and authorities.

Analysis:

The data is compiled and analysed through statistical analysis tools. It is given for deliberation to the head of the institution.

General Action Plan after data collection and analysis

- Annual Feedback Action Taken Report given after analysis of stakeholder feedback.
- Meetings are held at the department level, college level to discuss the suggestions and trends and feasibility of implementing the suggestions in the feedback.


Report on Student Feedback on Curriculum-2022-23

The feedback committee "Yathavath' has collected its feedback on 'Curriculum for the Academic year 2022-23. The feedback was collected through online mode through google forms.


The questions were well structured and formed as per the norms of UGC. This has been even accepted and approved by the chairman and Coordinator of IQAC.

A total of 986 responses were received. The responses were from the B.Sc., B.A., B. Com and M. Com students.



Observations:

- Learning value (in terms of skills, concepts, knowledge, analytical abilities or broadening perspective): Over 42 % of students were happy about the learning values in their curriculum.
- **Applicability** / **Relevance to real life situations:** Over 81.5% students were responded excellent, very good, and good and only 18.5 % of them are satisfactory.
- Extent of coverage of curriculum: Over 81.2% of the students were satisfied with good, very good and excellent for the depth of the curriculum.
- **Provision of reading materials in the library:** On a whole, 96% of majority of students were satisfied with materials in the library.
- Scope of co-curricular activities: about 22.4% of the students were not satisfied with scope of co-curricular activities and rest of the students very happy about the co-curricular activities in the college.
- Use of ICT (PPT, YouTube, LCD, Audio Visual etc.,) to cover curriculum by faculty: Majority of students were happy about the usage of ICT in the college.
- Are you aware of your Course Outcome, Programme Outcome: Over 85 % of students were aware of course and programme outcomes.
- Do your teachers assess your learning levels regularly by CIE: 91.6% of students were said yes for this question.



Observations:
